From the 50: East or West – exit Howe Avenue & Power Inn Road. Take Howe Ave. north to Fair Oaks. Turn left on Fair Oaks. Fair Oaks becomes “H” St as you cross-river. Center will be on right.

From the 80 traveling West – exit Capitol City frwy towards CA-99 and S/Sacramento. Take Arden Way exit. Turn left on Arden, then right on Howe to Fair Oaks. Go right on Fair Oaks Blvd. Fair Oaks becomes “H” Street once you cross-river, Scottish Rite Center is on the right.
