Under general supervision, performs a variety of skilled vegetation control, gardening, grounds maintenance, and fire prevention and mitigation work in the upkeep of unimproved land, landscaped areas, and grounds around offices, filter plants, maintenance yards, other East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) facilities.

Typical duties may include:

- Performing strenuous, physically demanding work on uneven and steep terrain using gas powered weed eaters and handheld and extension pole chainsaws.
- Applying various chemicals for weed abatement using pesticide rigs up to 100 gallons, pulling/dragging pesticide spray hoses up and down uneven terrain, and carrying and operating backpack and hand sprayers.
- Removing or replacing plants, sod, mulch, soil, and erosion control material on even and uneven terrain.
- Clearing vegetation and debris using landscape related equipment such as blowers, rakes, shovels, and pitchforks, etc.
- Installing, repairing, and operating automatic irrigation systems.
- Operating power and manual tools such as trenchers, shovels, picks, and breaker bars to complete grounds related projects.
- Pruning plants and trees using tools and equipment such as aerial lifts, ladders, hand chainsaws, power pole chainsaws and loppers.
- Performing fire abatement maintenance duties and special projects.

The salary range is \$6,068.00 per month increasing to \$6,371.00, \$6,690.00, and \$7,025.00 after 12, 24, and 36 months, respectively.

1. A high school diploma, or its equivalent, and either:
 - 2a. Twelve months of experience in EBMUD's Grounds Maintenance Specialist I classification, plus specified on-the-job training, and upon supervisory certification of proficiency. Six units or its equivalent of college, technical or trade school training in gardening, landscape architecture, horticulture or a closely related field may be substituted for six months of the required experience; OR
 - 2b. Twenty-four months of experience in gardening work providing knowledge and skills in general gardening and grounds maintenance methods. Six units or its equivalent of college, technical, or trade school training in gardening, landscape architecture, horticulture or a closely related field may be substituted for six months of the required experience.
3. Must possess a valid California driver's license and have a satisfactory driving record.
4. Must possess the physical characteristics to perform the critical and important duties of the job, including sufficient strength to lift and carry bags of fertilizer or equipment up to 50 pounds.
5. Must be willing to work where noxious plants and insects are present, work in a variety of weather conditions and work overtime as needed.
