



## Spray Technician

### Company Overview

### Principal Purpose of Job

Maintain the appearance and condition of a Commercial Business Park Landscape to highest quality and standards of Sunset Development Company.

Technician, will report directly to the Superintendent, and/or Assistant Superintendent. Technician is expected to perform all aspects of assigned job duties with limited supervision.

### Essential Job Functions:

1. Applies herbicide, fungicide, and pesticide chemicals by power pressure, hand spraying, spreaders, etc in the control of diseases, insects, and weeds in the landscape on various species of flowers, shrubs, and trees.
2. Mixes chemicals in accordance with prescribed procedures, and by label directions.
3. Observes safety precautions in the preparation, application, and storage of chemicals as outlined by EPA, CDPR, and County Agricultural Department.
4. Maintains proper documentation as required by the County Agricultural Department.
5. Must be able to take keen sense of ownership of responsibilities.
6. Applicator will meet all requirements for PPE (personal protection equipment).
7. Technician will assist the Superintendent and Assistant Superintendent in developing an on going IPM (integrated pest management) program.

### Work Environment/Physical Requirements:

1. Work occurs in certain cases adjacent to direct automotive traffic.
2. Standing & working on smooth and uneven surfaces during shift.
3. Able to work in an outdoor environment (sun, rain, wind, dust, etc.)
4. Repetitive lifting on certain tasks with weights of 1-50lbs, not to exceed the 50lb limit.
5. Supporting equipment on your back (back pack sprayer 22-25 lbs) at least 3 hours per day.
6. Some activities may require walking and/or pushing of equipment for extended periods of time.

### Qualifications:

1. At least 2 years spray experience, chemicals & fertilizers.
2. Able to obtain QAL or QAC license within 6 months of hire.
3. Applicant should have strong written & verbal skills, plus time management skills.
4. CDL and clean driving record meeting company insurance requirements.
5. Basic technology skills, specifically use of Ipad.
6. Bilingual in English/Spanish preferred, but not required.
7. Able to work effectively with individuals of differing knowledge and background.
8. Punctual and have dependable transportation.
